

**10/29/09 Meeting Dot Vote Results - Tasks that the RSG could undertake to accomplish its goals/objectives
Organized by Topic**

Disposal/Remedial Options

- **22 votes** - Weigh in on which (closure plans) are the most logical and in the best interest of the parties affected
- **17 votes** - Background presentations on the CKD leachate issue, including history, documents guiding the cleanup process, and efforts to date.
- **12 votes** - Bring everyone up to speed on current proposed remediation plan
- **11 votes** - Review alternatives to proposed remediation and issues with each
- **9 votes** - Develop recommendations for remediation and public process
- **8 votes** - Decide on our preferred alternative
- **7 votes** - Review and discuss the current closure plans
- **5 votes** - Technical or education assistance on certain documents or topics within the documents.
- **2 votes** - Prepare a critique of CMS consultant's RI/AE documents

Mercury/Contaminants

- **10 votes** - Conduct a workshop that focuses on mercury; CMS's bench scale testing of mercury removal efficiencies using various treatment technologies, and mercury material balance modeling for Lake Michigan

RSG Process

- **20 votes** - Clarify everyone's expectations, understand the goals and any agreed-upon timelines
- **15 votes** - Ensure engagement of all affected parties
- **5 votes** - Define the problem as precise as possible with everyone's agreement
- **4 votes** - Provide stakeholders with current information and access to resources to review and share with other interested parties
